

**Auburn School District
Proposed ESSER II and ESSER III Fund Uses
6-8-21**

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Coronavirus Response and Relief Appropriations ACT 2021 (CRRSA) and the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) was signed into law dedicating support for K-12 schools through Elementary and Secondary School Relief (ESSER) funds.

The purpose of the ESSER III funds is to help sustain the safe and effective operations of our schools and to address the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on student learning. No less than 20% of the funds received must be used to address the impact of lost instructional time.

Allowable activities for which the district can use the funds include:

- Prevention and mitigation strategies in response to COVID-19 – Cleaning and disinfecting supplies and equipment, PPE, personnel, training.
- Addressing the impact of lost instructional time through the implementation of evidence-based interventions, professional development, programs, materials, resources
- Technology – Educational equipment, hardware, software, infrastructure
- Addressing mental health needs – Evidence-based mental health and wellness programs for students and staff
- Repairing and improving school facilities and indoor air quality – School heating/cooling and ventilation systems
